Participant numbers will be limited to 44, the capacity of the coach. Only one delegate per school will be possible and partners will not be able to join this seminar. A firm expression of interest is requested by December 17, 2010. Those expressing interest will be notified by January 15th if a space has been reserved or if they are on a waiting list.

Early registration is advised as spaces will fill fast. The non-refundable seminar fee is \$2000 USD and will be due February 28, 2011. This early date is essential as pre-payment needs to be made for the hotels and game park.
